25/F23 Review of 2026/2027 draft budget

Proposal: to recommend draft budget to Full Council for approval

The budget was discussed line by line and in detail. Specific highlights were:

- Play equipment maintenance: Is it better to replace rather than continuously repair wooden equipment? s.106 money can be used to purchase new equipment.
- Electricity for street-lighting: Due to the Ofgem mandated change to billing of un-metered electricity supplies our account was now on the "market-wide half hourly settlement". Recent bills that has seen a marked increase in cost and the billed kw/h. Looking into this it seems we are being overcharged. All information has been emailed to brokers to help investigate the price increase. Agreed unanimously to cancel the Direct Debit for now and for the Clerk to contact broker, OfGem and SSE to investigate the increase.
- Building maintenance at the cemetery: Planned replacement of west facing doors. Future budgets to replace east facing. Using ear-marked reserve to reduce what is needed to be budgeted for so doors can be replaced in the next financial year.
- Tree work, including tree surveys: Concern raised about the potential/predicted increase of the tree work next year with having a very dry summer this year.
- One off additional cost of Chrishall Grange LHI, plus the additional costs of purchasing MVAS and solar power battery. Agreed to purchase solar power for existing machine, and divide the cost of the next machine between this budget and the following years budget.
- Office Equipment: ear-marked reserve total at £1000.00. Need will arise soon for a new printer, and also a device to download the data from the increasing number of MVAS machines.
- Councillor training increased budget due to 2026 being an election year, potential new councillors, plus general training need and potential training needed with local government re-organisation
- Election Contribution remains but ear-marked reserve will re-start after election.
- An absolute final precept figure would be known after 31st December interest payments.
- After adjustments had been made following the discussions, the proposal was moved.
