

Update – upcoming road closures in Shepreth

Dear residents and businesses,

Our work to deliver the Shepreth spur of the Melbourn Greenway is progressing well, and we are preparing to deliver the next stages of work in the village. Details of upcoming road closures are provided below.

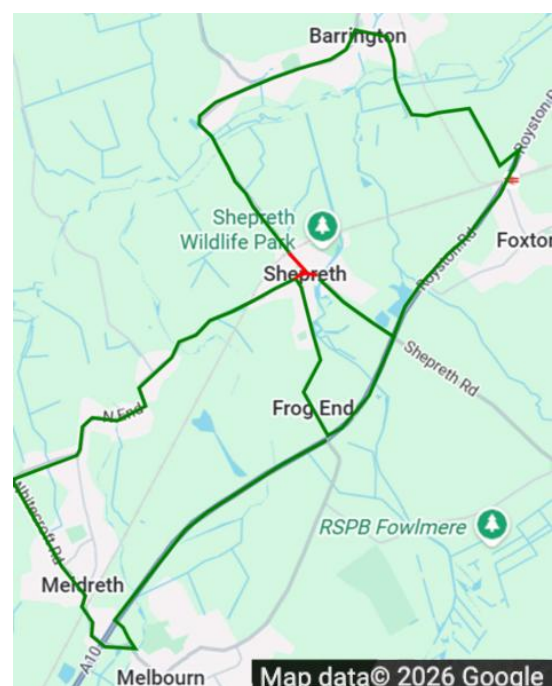
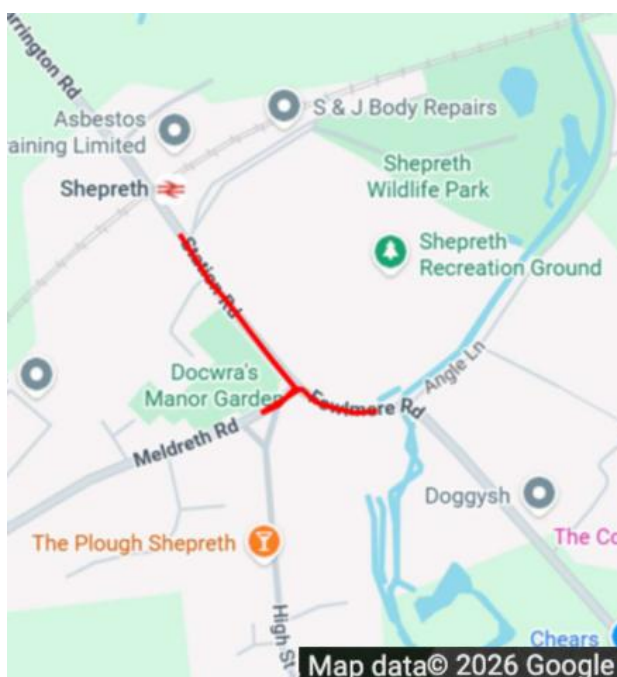
As part of the delivery of the project, we have identified an opportunity to further improve provision for all road users by resurfacing the section of Station Road between the entrance to the Station and the junction of Angle Lane and Fowlmere Road. This will include the junction of Station Road with Meldreth Road. To minimise disruption, these works will be completed overnight.

Station Road resurfacing - Thursday 9 July and Friday 10 July between 8pm and 6am

Access will be maintained for pedestrians, cyclists and emergency vehicles throughout the duration of these works, but please note that you may be asked to wait for a short period of time.

For residents wishing to access the works area in their vehicle, please approach the closure point closest to your property where a member of the team will assist you. There may be a delay whilst we ensure the area is safe for you. If you need immediate access to your vehicle, please park outside of the works zone.

Resurfacing work can be noisy, and we apologise for any disruption caused. We will aim to complete the loudest activities as early as possible.

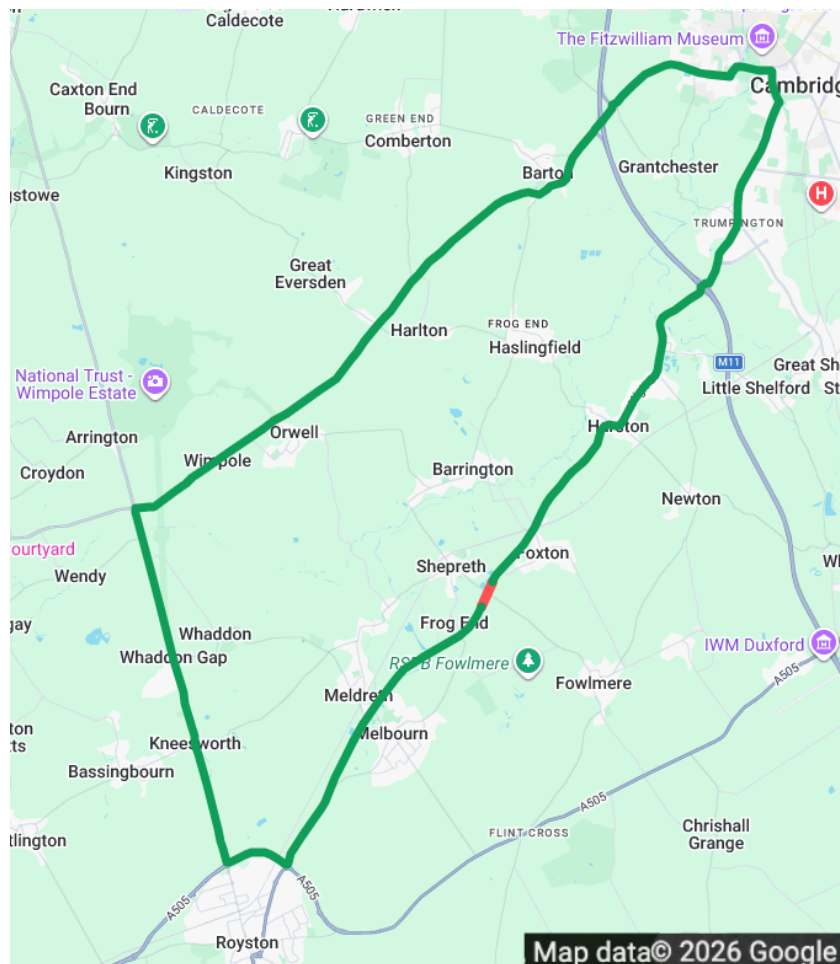


**Temporary traffic lights on the A10 – from Monday 13 July to Thursday 16 July
between 8pm and 6am**

To install streetlighting electrical ducting across the A10, we will be using temporary two-way traffic lights on the A10. Pedestrians access will be maintained during these works.

A10 Closure – Friday 17 July between 8pm and 6am

The A10 will be closed for one night so that we can install the traffic management required for works on Fowlmere Road and Shepreth Road between July and October. The existing road markings will be removed, and temporary markings will be installed to indicate no turning from the A10 to Fowlmere Road or Shepreth Road. Barriers will be installed on each side of the road, and a 30mph speed limit will be introduced for the safety of the site operatives. These temporary changes will be in place until the end of the project.



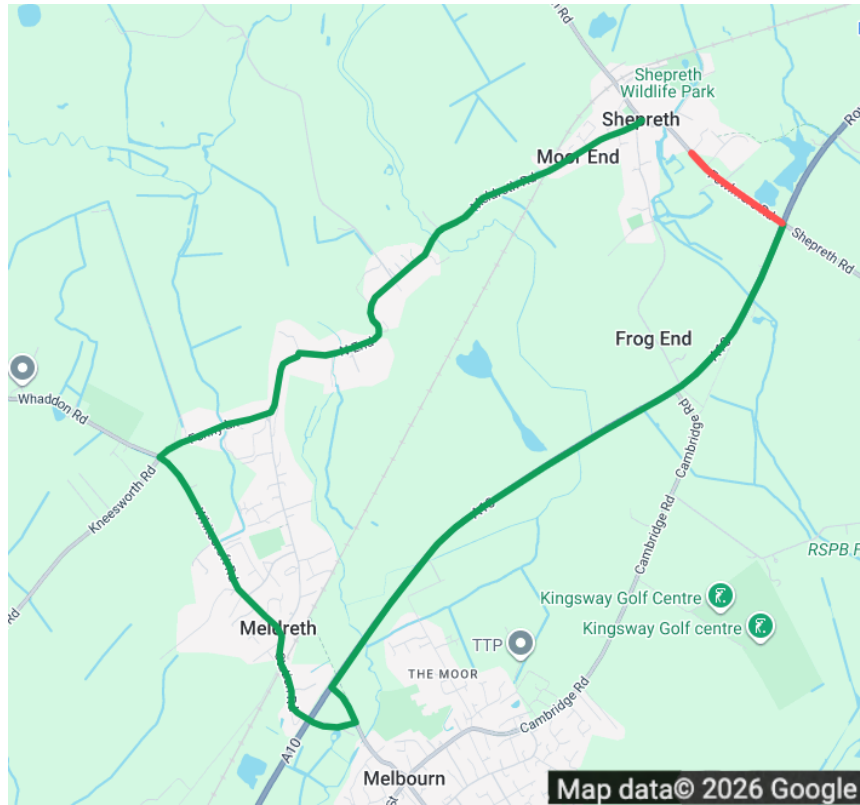
The official diversion route will be Royston Road (A10) – A505 – Old N Road (A1198) – Ermine Way (A1198) – Cambridge Road (A603) – Barton Road (A603) – Newnham Road (A603) – The Fen Causeway – Trumpington Road (A1134) – High Street (A1309) – Hauxton Road (A1309) – Cambridge Road (A10) – Royston Road (A10)

Fowlmere Road closure - Monday 13 July – October 2026

Fowlmere Road will be closed with no vehicle access to the A10. Vehicles will be able to use all other roads in Shepreth village. Access to properties along Fowlmere Road will be

maintained at all times, but vehicles must approach from the village. This closure is required to facilitate works on the A10. Once installed, the closure will be in place until all works are completed on site.

The diversion route for these works is shown below.



Monday 13 July – October 2026 Shepreth Road

Shepreth Road will be closed with no access to the A10. Vehicle drivers will be able to use all other roads in Fowlmere village. This closure is part of the works being carried out on the A10.

Please note, there will be no left or right turn from the A10 onto Fowlmere Road or Shepreth Road. A reduced speed limit of 30mph on the A10 will be introduced.
